RURAL DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES IN WEST BENGAL

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a high level delegation Review Committee have reviewed the implementation of various rural development schemes in West Bengal in the recent past;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of the observations of the said review;
- (d) whether there is any proposal of review the implementation of such schemes by such Committees in other States; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI PRADEEP JAIN `ADITYA`)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Rural Development review the status of implementation of various rural development programmes namely the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA), Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY)/National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM), Indira Awas Yojana (IAY), Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and National Social Assistance Programmes (NSAP) through a comprehensive monitoring mechanism, including Performance Review Committees (PRC) which review performance with all the State Governments, including West Bengal. The last meeting of PRC was held on 17th and 18th November, 2011 wherein all the State Governments including West Bengal participated.

(d) & (e): Review of implementation of all the schemes in the PRC meeting is an established monitoring and review mechanism where all States are covered.
