**Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Union Government proposes to provide 50 per cent of the power generated from power projects of the National Thermal Power Projects to the home State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Bihar; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRI K.C. VENUGOPAL)

(a) to (c): The Government of India has approved allocation of 50% of power to the 'Home' States from the 14 upcoming power projects of NTPC Limited, and from all new projects of Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited. Orders of this Ministry dated 17th January, 2011 are as at Annex.

Ministry of Power has also agreed for 50% of allocation of Power to Bihar from Stage-II of NTPC's Barh Super Thermal Power Station (1320 MW).
