(a) & (b): Insurance Regulatory & Development Authority (IRDA) has reported that they have received 17 complaints during the last two years. On the basis of complaints, IRDA reviewed the performance of the concerned institutes in the routine check up, accreditation of 4 online Institutes was terminated during the period.
