(a) The Major Scheme implemented by the Ministry for development of youth and adolescent of the country is the National Programme for Youth and Adolescent Development(NPYAD) Scheme. The details of fund earmarked under the scheme for the last three years and the current year is as under:-

The major programmes under the scheme are Youth Leadership and Personality Development, Promotion of National Integration, Promotion of Adventure and Development and Empowerment of Adolescents. The fund allocated for the above programmes for the last three years are as under:-
