(a) to (e): According to UNDP Human Development Indices: A Statistical update 2008 released on 18-12-2008, India ranked 132 amongst 179 countries in the year 2006. In value terms it shows a progress over previous years with human development index (HDI), value of 0.609 in 2006 as compared to 0.561 in the year 2000. All countries included in the HDI are classified into one of three categories: high human development index (HDI value 0.800 and above) medium human development index (HDI value 0.500-0.799) and low human development index (HDI value less than 0.500). India has been positioned in medium human development group by UNDP.
