**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned the construction of road parallel to No Man`s Land on Indo-Nepal border;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the funds sanctioned therefor; and
- (c) the agency through which the said project is likely to be executed and the time by which it is likely to be completed?

**Answer**

(a) to (c): A proposal for construction and upgradation of roads along the Indo-Nepal border has been approved by the Government on 18.11.2010. This proposal interalia envisages construction of 1377 km of roads along Nepal border i.e. 173 km in Uttarakhand, 640 km in Uttar Pradesh and 564 km in Bihar at an estimated cost of Rs. 3853 crores. The construction work will be executed by the State Public Works Departments and will be completed over a period of five years commencing from 01st April, 2011.
