KILLING OF IPS OFFICERS

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of cases of killing of Indian Police Service (IPS) Officers reported in the country during the last three years;
- (b) the details of the cases in which action has been initiated against the accused;
- (c) whether the Union Government has raised the issue of security and service conditions of officers of All India Services with the State Governments; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof alongwith the outcome thereon?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a): During the last three years, two IPS officers have been killed while performing their duties.

2009-10 : 1

2010-11 : 0

2011-12 : 1

(b): In the year 2009-10, one IPS officer was killed during the operations against Naxals at Rajnandgaon, Chattishgarh. In 2011-12, one IPS officer was killed by the mining mafia at Morena, Madhya Pradesh. The case has been transferred to CBI.

(c) to (d): As and when threat to any officers including IPS officers are reported, the concerned State Governments are sensitized and advised to strengthen the security to such officers.
