TERRORIST CAMPS IN NEIGHBOURING COUNTRIES

**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether there are reports that terrorist training camps are still functional in the neighbouring countries including Bangladesh and Pakistan;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereto?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (c): As per the available intelligence inputs, there are approximately 42 training camps in Pakistan and Pakistan occupied Kashmir and majority of these camps are reported to be active. However, there is no specific input to indicate that terrorist camps are still functional in other neighbouring countries. Government continuously monitors all developments having a bearing on India's National Security and takes all necessary steps to safeguard it.
