- (b) if so, the details of such cases reported during the current year, State-wise; and
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereto?

Answer

MINISTER OF THE STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

(a) to (c): No Foreign Intelligence agency is permitted to have their offices in India. However, some foreign intelligence agencies from time to time send their operatives under diplomatic cover. Their activities are kept under close watch to prevent them from carrying out anti India activities.
