**Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the State Government of Chhattisgarh has submitted several proposals regarding construction of roads and bridges under the Road Requirement Plan (RRP) in left wing extremism affected areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the said proposals are likely to be approved?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI JITENDRA SINGH)

(a) to (c): On the basis of request made by the State Government and after prioritizing the stretches in consultations with the State DGPs/Security forces, 2092 km roads in 7 Districts affected by Left Wing Extremism of Chhattisgarh have been identified for development under Road Requirement Plan-I (RRP-I). Further, 1338 km road stretches have been identified by Ministry of Home Affairs under RRP-II for Chhattisgarh.

The State Government has submitted 48 estimates covering 1955 km length including bridges thereon for approval under RRP-I, out of which 47 estimates covering 1946 km length have been approved at an estimates cost of Rs. 2620 crore.
