(a) to (b): There are some border disputes between the States of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. The Government of Assam has filed Original Suit No.1 of 89 in the Supreme Court of India for demarcation of boundaries between the states of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. The Supreme Court vide its judgment and order dated 25.9.2006 has appointed a Local Commission for identification of boundaries of the States of Assam and Arunachal Pradesh. The Local Commission is continuing its hearing.
