(a) to (g): The ARC in its 6 Report titled `Local Governance - An inspiring journey into the Future5 has recommended that `Recruitment for Hospitals and schools should be made to an institution/Society, moving away from non-accountable State level recruitment`. This recommendation has been accepted by the Government. As recruitment for hospitals and schools is a State subject, the recommendation has been sent to state governments for consideration and implementation.
