**Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Administrative Reforms Commission has recommended to hand over the appointment of aided school teacher to the Public Service Commission and give a central role to the civic bodies in the management of schools;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Administrative Reforms Commission has also recommended to make the recruitment of teacher more transparent and accountable to the local communities;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Union Government has implemented these recommendations;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) if not, the steps taken by the Union Government in this regard?

(a) to (g): The ARC in its 6 Report titled 'Local Governance - An inspiring journey into the Future' has recommended that 'Recruitment for Hospitals and schools should be made to an institution/Society, moving away from non-accountable State level recruitment'. This recommendation has been accepted by the Government. As recruitment for hospitals and schools is a State subject, the recommendation has been sent to state governments for consideration and implementation.
