(a) Chief Minister, Uttar Pradesh in his letter dated 12th April, 2012 addressed to the Prime Minister has sought funds for implementing schemes for groundwater recharge and rainwater harvesting in 108 over-exploited or critical blocks of the State. The estimated cost for implementing these schemes is indicated in the letter as Rs.1500 crore during the 12th Five Year Plan.

(b) Central Ground Water Board under Ministry of Water Resources is formulating a new scheme on Accelerated Artificial Recharge to Groundwater for implementation across the country in the 12th Five Year Plan.
