- (a) & (b) The number of students enrolled in Classes I-XII in the country during 2009-10(Provisional) is 24,33,56,708. Data on number of students enrolled is not maintained separately for Government schools and Private schools.
- (c) & (d) The number of Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe(ST) students enrolled in Classes I-XII in the country during 2007-08 to 2009-10 shows an increasing trend. Details are given below:-
