- (b) to (d): The Central Empowered Committee (CEC), constituted by the Hon'ble Supreme Court is hearing a Public Interest Litigation case regarding transfer of Forest Land for this project. As per CEC directions, work on the project has been stopped. Further action on this project would be taken only after the decision of CEC is received.
