- (a) & (b): Upgradation/renovation/modernization of railway stations including railway stations falling in the tribal dominated areas is a continuous process and is undertaken every year in accordance with the laid down norms based on traffic growth and inter-se priorities.
- (c) to (e): Minimum Essential Amenities (MEA) have been provided at Nardana railway station as per norms.
