- (a) & (b): Upgradation of passenger amenities is a continuous process. Minimum Essential Passenger Amenities and other important amenities have already been provided at Kopergaon station. Besides, the following works (Costing Rs.123.20 lakh) have been taken in hand and planned for completion by March, 2010:
- (i) Provision of ramp, toilet, water tap for physically handicapped persons;
- (ii) Provision of pathway connecting platforms for handicapped persons; and
- (iii) Provision of pipeline connection from Kopergaon Nagar Parishad.
