## Answer

(a) & (b): During the 12th Five Year Plan, the projected demand of natural gas and estimated domestic availability would leave a shortfall of 189 MMSCMD in 2012-13 to 292 MMSCMD in 2014-15 which may have to be met through import of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG), subject to RLNG import capacity constraints.
