(a): The work of Talcher – Bimlagarh (154 km) new line was included in Budget 2003-04 at an anticipated cost of Rs. 810.78 crore. An expenditure of Rs. 27.98 crore has been incurred upto March 2009 and an outlay of Rs. 10 crore has been provided in Budget 2009-10.

Land acquisition has been taken up. Major bridges have also been taken up.

(b) & (c): The work will be progressed and completed in the coming years as per the availability of resources. Target date of completion is yet to be fixed.
