(a) to (c) As per the information provided by the National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) State/UT wise details of infanticide and abandonment of children and cases registered, cases charge sheeted, cases convicted, persons arrested, person charge sheeted and persons convicted for the years 2009, 2010 and 2011 respectively are given at Annexure I & II respectively. However, separate data on female child is not maintained by NCRB.
