- (a) & (b) The details and status of proposals received from State Governments for Central Assistance (CA) under Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP) to the major/medium irrigation projects in Drought Prone Areas (DPAs) including Karnataka during the last three years (2009-10 to 2011-12) and the current year (2012-13) is given from Annexure-I(a) to Annexure-I(d). The Status of CA released to Surface MI schemes under AIBP is given at Annexure-I(e).
- (c) The proposals received for Central Assistance (CA) under AIBP from State Governments are processed on year to year basis as per the Guidelines of the Programme and the time taken for approval is related to the promptness of submission of compliance to the observations, if any of Central Water Commission/Ministry of Water Resources/Ministry of Finance.
