- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has conducted any study in this regard; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN)

- (a) & (b): At present the Central Government in the Ministry of Home Affairs has no proposal to introduce Student Police Cadet (SPC) in the country.
- (c) & (d): No, Madam.
- (e) & (f): No study on SPC has been conducted by the Government so far. However, the National Police Mission under the Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D) have prepared a proposal on 'Community Policing for Students' on the basis of the Student Police Cadet model of Kerala, which is being successfully implemented in 130 Government / Government-aided schools in Kerala by Home and Education Departments of that State. The proposal has been examined in the Ministry of Home Affairs and the BPR&D has been asked to prepare an advisory note on 'Community Policing for Students' and send to this Ministry.
