UNDERGROUND DRAINAGE FACILITIES/ STORM WATER DRAINAGE SYSTEM

**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether some State Governments including Government of Andhra Pradesh have submitted some proposals for providing underground drainage facilities/storm water drainage system under Urban Infrastructure and Governance Project (UI&G);
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) the action taken by the Union Government thereon alongwith funds allocated and released thereunder, project-wise; and
- (d) the present status of the projects?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a) to (d) :Yes, Madam. Some State Governments including Andhra Pradesh have submitted Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) for providing Underground Drainage Facilities (UGD) and Storm Water Drainage System (SWD) under Urban Infrastructure and Governance (UIG) of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) which have been appraised in this Ministry. 62 number of DPRs have been approved by Central Sanctioning & Monitoring Committee (CSMC) under UIG till 31-10-2009 for UGD & 105 number of DPRs have been approved by CSMC for SWD. The additional central assistance committed and funds released project-wise is at annexure. The projects for which funds have been released are at various stages of implementation.
