SEWER SYSTEM IN DELHI

Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is absence of sewer system in some parts of Delhi;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the remedial measures taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SAUGATA ROY)

(a): Yes, Madam.

(b) to (c): The Government of National Capital Territory of Delhi (GNCTD) has informed that the unsewered areas of Delhi mostly consist of

- (i) 44 unauthorized/regularized colonies,
- (ii) 27 urban villages,
- (iii) 1583 unauthorized colonies,
- (iv) 189 rural villages,
- (v) 1080 JJ clusters.

GNCTD has further informed that sewerage system is being extended to 39 rural villages & 45 colonies. For many unsewered areas, the sewerage system is at various stages of planning or execution.
