**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether some State Governments including Government of Kerala has submitted Detailed Project Reports for setting up of Metro Rail Projects in their respective States during the last one year and as on date;
- (b) if so, the details and present status thereof State-wise;
- (c) the total estimated cost of these projects alongwith its funding pattern; and
- (d) the target date of beginning and completion of projects?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF URBAN DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUGATA ROY)

(a) to (c): The Central Government have received Detailed Project Report for extension of Delhi Metro Rail from Mundka to Bahadurgarh from Government of Haryana during the last one year. The Detailed Project Report for Kochi Metro Rail Project has been received from Government of Kerala on 12.9. 2005. The details are given below:-
