- (c) the names of the States in which this scheme was launched along with the progress made therein;
- (d) whether this scheme is likely to be implemented in all the States in view of its success; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

- (a) & (b) The High Level Committee on Financing Infrastructure has formed a Sub Group headed by Secretary (WR) to make recommendations on policy and other changes to be initiated in the sector (Irrigation) for attracting private investments. Accordingly, the Sub Group has formulated a draft proposal on financing of Micro-Irrigation through PPP.
- (c) No such scheme has been launched by the Ministry of Water Resources so far.
- (d) & (e) If any such scheme is introduced, it will be applicable to all States.
