(a) to (b): Director General Level Talks (DGLT) were held between the Border Security Force (BSF) and Pakistan Rangers from 01-05 July, 2012 in New Delhi.

Both sides discussed various issues as under:-

- # Construction of bundh in Indian territory,
- # Establishing telephonic contacts between both the border guarding forces at Sector Level,
- # Hostile firing and cease-fire violation, unprovoked firing n unarmed innocent civilians,
- # Unauthorized defence construction works,
- # Working boundary as called by Pakistan and international boundary as termed by India,
- # Installation of white poles by BSF,
- # Preventive measures to be taken to stop smugglers/ miscreants in order not to succeed in their designs, and
- # Support to newly constructed boundary pillars.

Both sides expressed their satisfaction on the successful completion of Talks which was held in very cordial and purposeful environment and various issues, laid for discussion, were amicably resolved, making the meeting very meaningful and progressive.
