- (a) whether the power utilities prefershort-term contracts to ward off congestion; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF POWER (SHRIK.C. VENUGOPAL)

- (a): Power utilities generally prefer long-term contracts to ensure certainty of access in transmission corridor. As per the regulations of Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (CERC), long-term access to transmission system is accorded higher priority over the medium term and short-term transactions. In the event of curtailment of power flow due to transmission constraints or grid security, short-term transactions are curtailed first, followed by medium term contracts and then long-term contracts.
