- (a) whether the Union Government has approved the proposal of the Government of Tamil Nadu to set up a Petroleum, Chemicals and Petrochemicals Investment Region (PCPIR) in Cuddalore and Nagapattinam districts;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the PCPIRs have already been approved in many States; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, location-wise?

Answer

- (a) Yes, Sir, the Government has approved the proposal of the Government of Tamil Nadu for Setting up Petroleum, Chemical and Petrochemical Investment Region (PCPIR) in Cuddalore and Nagapattinam Districts.
- (b): The proposal involves setting up of a PCPIR in Cuddalore & Nagapattinam districts covering an area of 256.83 sq km. It envisages Government of India support of Rs. 2643 crore comprising of VGF Funding for 2 road projects, Desalination and Common Effluent Treatment Plants and direct budgetary support for creation of rail infrastructure.
- (c)&(d): Yes, Sir, the Government has approved proposals for setting of PCPIRs in Visakhapatnam-Kakinada region in Andhra Pradesh, at Paradip in Orissa and at Dahej in Gujarat.
