- (a) to (c): The following steps have been taken to upgrade the facilities for unloading of cargo at the Major Ports, including at Mumbai, Chennai and Kolkata Ports:-
- (i) Mechanization of berths.
- (ii) Creation of additional berths.
- (iii) Improving Rail-Road connectivity; and
- (iv) Introduction of Electronic Data Processing System for cargo handling.
