**Will the Minister of URBAN DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the assistance is provided under the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) for construction of pedestrian paths;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the total number of proposals received, sanctioned and approved for the construction of pedestrian paths during each of the last three years and the current year, State-wise; and
- (c) the total funds allocated, released and utilised under the Mission for each of the above mentioned proposals along with the current status of each of these projects?

**Answer**

(a)to (c): Yes, Madam. No project for construction of pedestrian paths have been approved during the last three years under Urban Infrastructure & Governance (UIG) Sub-Mission of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM). No project has been approved in the current year also as the normal period of Mission is completed on 31-03-2012 and the Government has extended the period for two years i.e. upto 31-03-2014 for completion of ongoing projects and reforms only.
