(a) whether the Government is considering for expansion/ restructuring/promoting of the National Service Scheme (NSS);

(b) if so, the details thereof State-wise; and

(c) the details of universities and schools in which the scheme is functioning, State-wise?

(a) & (b) :NSS, a Centrally Sponsored Scheme, launched in 1969 with a strength of 40,000 volunteers has now grown to a strength of 32 lakh volunteers covering 299 Universities , 15666 colleges and 10762 schools spread over all the States and Union Territories.

As a part of the on-going process of restructuring and promoting NSS, Government of India introduced a 100 ten day adventure camps and 2 twelve day Mega Camps annually from the year 2009 onwards. A Statement indicating Volunteer Strength for the year 2012-13, State–wise is given at Annexure-I.

(c): The State-wise details of universities and schools in which the scheme is functioning are given at Annexure-II.
