- (b) whether hockey has not been accorded the status of national game as per the information provided in the recent past under the Right to Information Act;
- (c) if so, the reaction of the Government in this regard;
- (d) whether the content of Government website has also been changed after providing the said information; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and the steps/action taken by the Government to accord the status of national game to hockey?
