(a)to(d): To augment capacity for better and improved train services, 47 doubling projects covering a length of 1611 km & 4 Gauge Conversion projects covering a length of 1152 km. falling fully/partly in West Bengal have been taken up. Electrification for 701 km. of track in West Bengal has also been taken up.
