- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H. MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Lalitpur-Singrauli new line connects Khajuraho and Panna (Ajaigarh). On this project, Mahoba-Khajuraho (65 km) and Lalitpur-Mawai-Khargapur (88 km) have been completed. Proposal to connect Chitrakoot via Bariarpur-Ajaigarh is not presently under consideration as Chitrakoot is already connected to Khajuraho via Banda-Mahoba.
