(a) and (b) The Concession Agreement for four-laning of Amravati – Jalgaon section of NH-6 has been signed on 06.06.2012. Akola to Malkapur section forms a part of this project stretch.

(c) and (d) Minor potholes have been repaired. Maintenance including repair of potholes, is a continuous process to keep the road in traffic worthy conditions.
