(a) & (b) Irrigation being a State Subject, the irrigation projects are planned, executed and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. As per the information from Government of Andhra Pradesh, the water provided from Nagarjuna Sagar Dam to Krishna Delta does not prove costly for the areas and districts of Telangana. The details of water released for irrigation and drinking water needs to Krishna delta and Telangana regions from Nagarjuna Sagar dam for the last three years is at Annexure-I.
