Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to implement the Swaminathan Commission Report to link the Minimum Support Price (MSP) with the Wholesale Price Index (WPI);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the proposal is likely to be implemented?

Answer

(a) to (c): The National Commission on Farmers recommended that the Minimum Support Price (MSP) should be at least 50% more than the weighted average cost of production. This recommendation, however, has not been accepted by the Government. MSP is recommended by the Commission for Agricultural Cost & Prices (CACP) based on objective criteria and considering variety of relevant factor.
