(a) to (c): The Ministry of Agriculture has formulated a draft 'Agricultural Produce Inter-State Trade and Commerce (Development and Regulation) Bill, 2012 to promote, develop and regulate inter-state trade and commerce of agricultural produce to facilitate its barrier free movement across the country. This is intended to benefit both farmers and consumers by providing a common national level market and bringing down the marketing cost of agriculture produce. The draft bill has been sent to the States and other stake holders for their views in the matter.
