- (i) Dwelling Units on DDA plots by 2.5 lakh Private individuals
- (ii) Dwelling Units in Joghi Jopri 2.4 lakh
- (${\sf JJ}$) resettlement colonies
- (iii) Flats allotted by the DDA 3.94 lakh
- (iv) Dwelling Units constructed 2.00 lakh
 on plots allotted to Co-operative
 Group Housing Society
- (v) Dwelling Units through $\,$ 0.85 lakh Rohini plotted housing scheme $\,$

Total = 11.69 lakh
