- (a) the total inflow of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the food processing sector registered during 2011-12;
- (b) whether keeping in view the continuous rise in FDI in the sector, the Government is considering to amend the Agricultural Produce Market Act (APMA) to encourage investors to contact farmers directly; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a): Total inflow of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in food processing sector during 2011-12 was Rs.826.16 crore (US \$170.21 Million).
- (b) & (c): Ministry of Agriculture has prepared a model Agricultural Produce Marketing (Development and Regulation) Act in 2003 and circulated to all States and Union Territories for adoption. There is no proposal to amend the model Act.
