(a) to (e) No, Sir. There is no proposal under consideration for giving financial assistance to the poor students for studies in the foreign countries. Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Higher Education) does not provide any financial assistance to the poor students for pursuing higher studies in the foreign countries/ abroad. This Department only processes scholarships offered by foreign governments under Cultural Exchange Programme/ Educational Exchange Programme or related programme. Final selection rests with the donor country.
