- (c): As per Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) affiliation Bye-laws, the fees charged by the school should be commensurate with the infrastructure and the facilities provided.
- (d)&(e): As per the scheme/syllabus in CBSE affiliated schools, a student has to study English upto VIIIth class. In classes IX and X, a student has to study two languages out of which one is compulsorily either Hindi or English. In classes XI and XII, a student can opt either English or Hindi as one of the Languages. Both Hindi and English can also be offered simultaneously by students.
