APPOINTMENT OF TEACHERS ON CONTRACT BASIS

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is acute shortage of teachers of various courses in Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs);
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether teachers on contract basis have been appointed at large scale in place of regular teachers in KVs; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

(a) & (b) As on 1st March, 2012, out of total sanctioned strength of 40,800 teachers in all Kendriya Vidyalayas, 5,609 posts of teachers were lying vacant all over the country. The occurrence of vacancies is on account of retirements, resignations, sanctioning of new schools etc and new appointment to fill these up is a continuous process. However, there is a provision to appoint teachers on contractual basis so that studies of the students are not adversely affected.

(c) & (d) The State-wise details of the teachers engaged on contractual basis for various durations during the year 2011 are annexed.
