CCTV CAMERAS IN TRAINS

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Indian Railways have proposed to install CCTV cameras or any other safety gadgets in the premier trains of Rajdhani Express, Shatabdi Express and Duronto Express to nab and minimize theft cases as well as to check the nuisance created by group of ticketless eunuchs;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor and the details of alternate methods, if any, to control such cases?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI K.H.MUNIYAPPA)

(a) to (c): Presently there is no proposal for provision of CCTV cameras in trains. To supplement the efforts of States in strengthening of security over railways, various measures have been initiated which include installation of Internet Protocol based CCTV surveillance system under an Integrity Security System over 202 railway stations, access control at all the major railway stations, escorting of trains etc. In addition to these measures, legal action is taken against nuisance creators under provisions of the Railways Act etc.
