(a) to (d) The Government has expressed its interest in the full membership of Nuclear Suppliers Group (NSG). United States, France and Russia have publicly stated their support for India's membership of NSG. NSG deliberations are confidential in nature. A decision on India's membership is subject to consensus among NSG members.
