- (b) & (c): Recommendations made by the Second Administrative Reforms Commission in its Seventh Report titled 'Capacity Building For Conflict Resolution Friction To Fusion' relate to various Ministries/Departments. The decision of the Government on various recommendations have been forwarded to Ministries/Departments concerned for appropriate action. Out of a total number of 126 recommendations, 111 recommendations have been accepted. 51 accepted recommendations have been implemented, so far. The decisions taken by the Government on remaining accepted recommendations are at various stages of implementation.
