- (a) whether it is a fact that micro water harvesting projects have turned around rural life in the water starved regions in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is considering to popularise micro water harvesting in water starved regions in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the manner in which the farmers is likely to be benefited by these projects?

Answer

(a) to (e): Farmers are provided assistance for rain water harvesting structures under all major programmes of Ministry of Agriculture like Macro-Management of Agriculture (MMA), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY), National Food Security Mission (NFSM), National Horticulture Mission (NHM) etc., for providing protective/ supplementary irrigation to standing crops. These structures are mainly in the form of farm ponds, percolation tanks, check dams etc., which help in in-situ moisture conservation, rain water harvesting during dry spells besides enhancing irrigation coverage. These interventions have enhanced production and productivity of agricultural crops in rain- fed areas.
