Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the National Highways Authority of India have pulled down the compound wall of a monument popularly known as Chikkajala Fort as part of the road widening works on National Highway-4 reroute the Devanahalli airport;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken or being taken by the NHAI to rebuild the monument?

Answer

(a) Yes, Madam.

(b) & (c) The compound wall of a monument of length approx.94 mts has been acquired for construction of service road and High Speed Rail Corridor. The rebuilding of structure shall be taken up by the beneficiary since suitable compensation (Rs.10,93,780) towards reconstruction of the structure has been included in the LA award.
